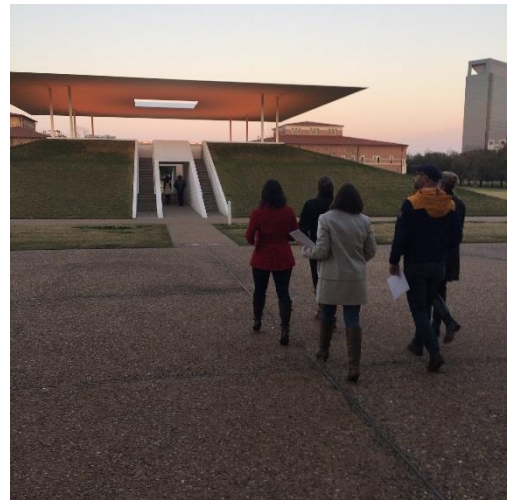




***Houston: The City With No Limits* Press Tour highlights the region's vibrant culture and quality of life**
