- Houston is home to the headquarters of 26 *Forbes Global 2000* companies with total assets of \$785 billion.
- *Forbes* screens for the biggest companies in four metrics; sales, profits, assets and market value. Their market value calculation is as of April 2016 closing prices, including all common shares outstanding. Each company receives a separate score for each metric based on where it ranks on the metric's 2000 list. If a company ranks below any metric's 2000 list cut-off, it receives a zero score for that metric. The scores are summed for all four metrics (equally weighted) and compile a composite score for each company based on their rankings for sales, profits, assets and market value. The companies are then sorted in descending order by the highest composite score and given their *Forbes Global 2000* rank. The highest composite score gets the highest rank.
