- According to the National Biodiesel Board and Biodiesel Magazine, Texas' annual biodiesel production capacity of 463 million gallons is the highest in the U.S. With 9 biodiesel plants, Texas is tied with Iowa and Missouri for the most number of biodiesel plants in the U.S.
- The Houston area represents more than 77.3 percent of all biodiesel production capacity in the state of Texas. Houston has more than 13 percent of the U.S. total in biofuel refining capacity (2,756 million gallons).
- The Houston MSA is eligible for grants through the Texas Department of Environmental Quality's Alternative Fueling Facilities Program (AFFP). These grants aim to promote the availability of biodiesel. According to DriveBiodiesel the state of Texas has 46 fueling stations where biodiesel is available.
