- According to the U.S. Census Bureau's *2008 County Business Patterns*, there are 261 computer and electronic manufacturers in the 10-county Houston-Sugar Land-Baytown Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA).
- Houston's computer and electronics manufacturing industry employs a local workforce of approximately 18,740.
- Within Houston's computer and electronic industry, Hewlett Packard is the largest area employer, with 9,000 local employees; followed by Schlumberger Integrated Productivity & Conveyance—5,500 local employees, Goodman Global – 2,500 local employees, Texas Instruments Incorporated—1,800 local employees, and Foxconn Corp—1,200 local employees.
- According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics' *2009 Metropolitan Area Occupational Employment and Wage Estimates (OES)*, there are approximately 22,290 computer programmers and software engineers in the Houston MSA.
- The local gross revenue of Houston's ten largest computer network and systems integrators, ranked by revenue, totaled \$195.6 million in 2009, according to the *Houston Business Journal*.
