

The Houston Airport System (HAS) handled 59.5 million passengers in the 12 months ending June '19. That's a 7.5 percent increase from the 55.3 million handled in the 12 months ending June '18 and a 12-month record high. The 12-month international passenger volume totaled 11.9 million, up 4.8 percent from 11.4 million in the preceding 12 months. Domestic volume totaled 47.6 million, an 8.2 percent increase from 44.0 million.



HOUSTON AIRPORT SYSTEM TRAFFIC 12-Months Ending in June

HAS handled 5.386 million passengers in June '19, a 0.5 percent increase from the 5.362 million passengers handled during June '18.
