



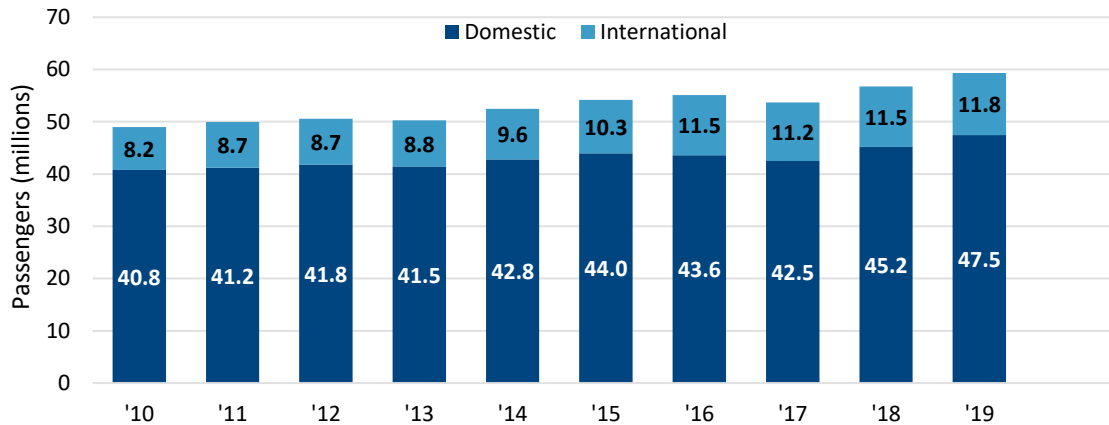

September 30, 2019

The Houston Airport System (HAS) handled 59.3 million passengers in the 12 months ending August '19. That's a 4.5 percent increase from the 56.8 million handled in the 12 months ending August '18. The 12-month international passenger volume totaled 11.8 million, up 2.5 percent from 11.5 million in the preceding 12 months. Domestic volume totaled 47.5 million, a 5.0 percent increase from 45.2 million.
