


## **Living Cost Comparison**

Houston offers a low cost of living while maintaining a high quality of life with the amenities expected in a world-class city.

The C2ER Cost of Living Index for Q1 '19 indicates that Houston's living costs are 4.6 percent below
the nationwide average and 25.8 percent below the average of the nation's 20 most populous
metropolitan areas, ranking it third most affordable among its peers.
