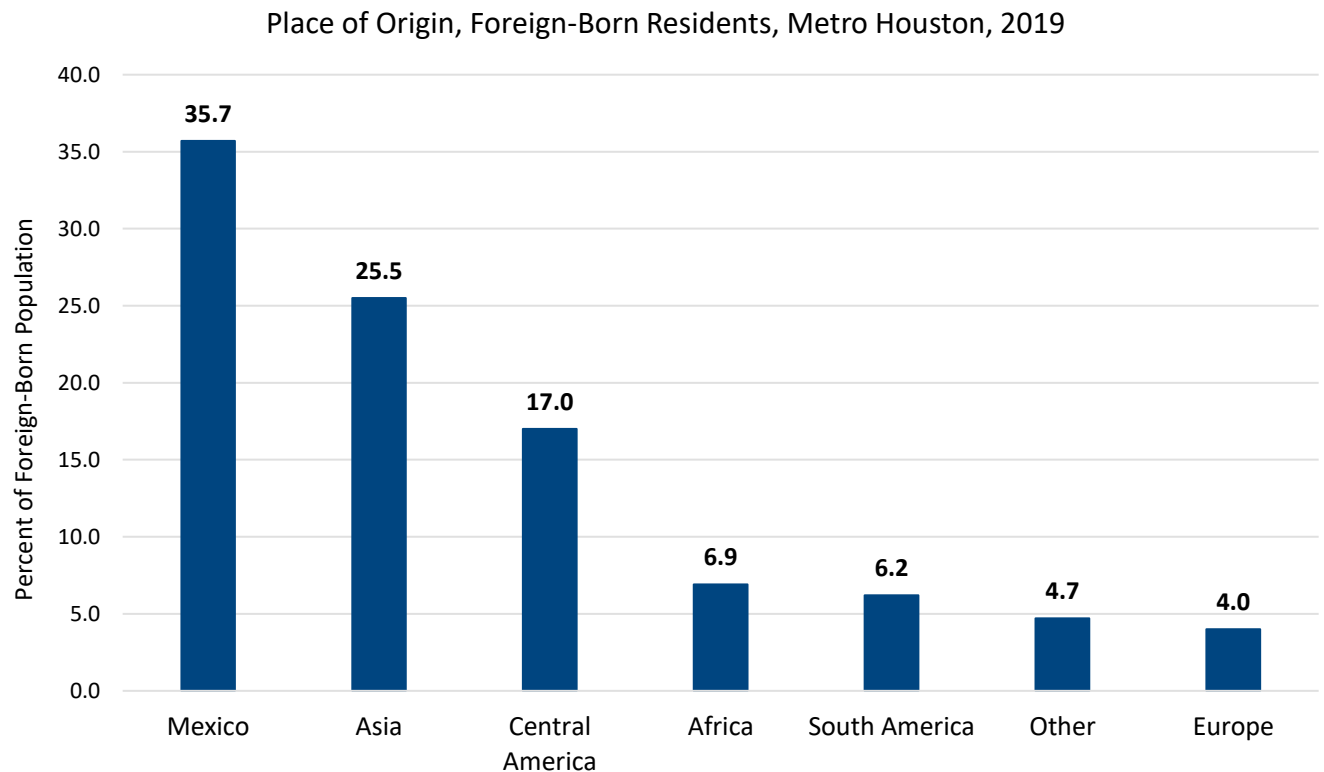


Foreign-Born Population

Nearly one in four Houstonians was born outside the U.S.

- In '19, the Houston Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) contained an estimated 1.7 million foreign-born residents, according to the U.S. Census Bureau. This figure represents 23.4 percent of the metro population.
- Mexico accounts for a third of Houston's foreign-born residents (591,302). El Salvador (135,071) was the birthplace of the next largest group from Central America, followed by Honduras (89,237) and Guatemala (40,529).
- One-fourth of Houston's foreign-born residents were born in Asia (421,952). Asian nations with the largest populations in Houston include Vietnam (96,184), India (89,876), China (67,571), Philippines (43,778) and Pakistan (27,904).
