Houston's total crime rate has declined significantly in the past decade.

- Since '10, property crime rates in the Houston metro area have decreased by 1.8 percent, while • violent crime rates have dropped by 33.6 percent.
- Burglary has increased 58.8 percent, auto theft is up 1.2 percent and larceny dropped 29.2 percent.
- In '20, the Houston metro area's total crime rate was 3,249.2 per 100,000 residents, a decrease of 28.8% from '10.
