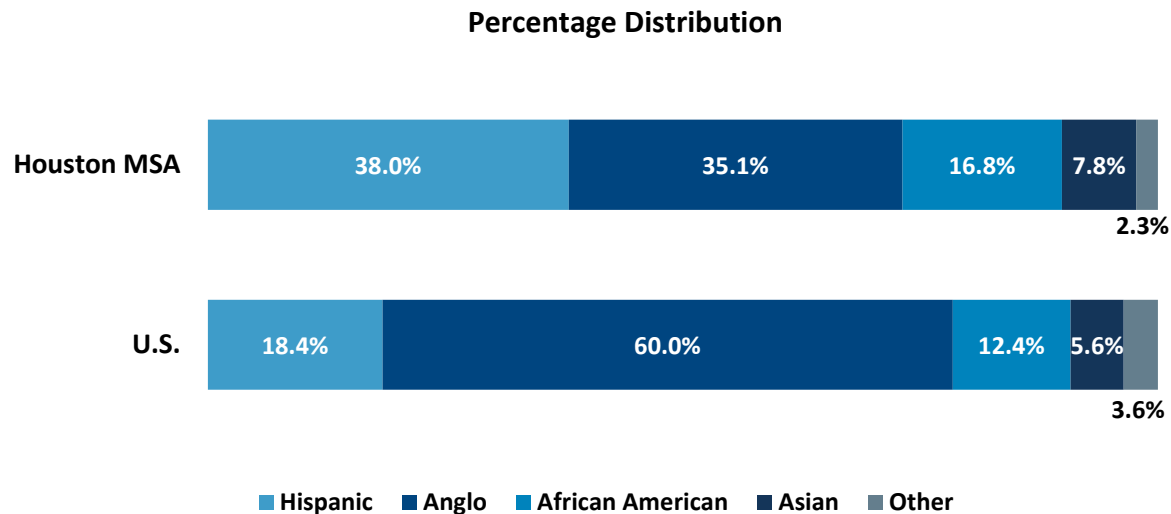


Race/Ethnicity

Houston is more racially and ethnically diverse than the nation as a whole.

- The U.S. Census Bureau's 2019 American Community Survey showed that no racial or ethnic group constitutes a majority of the Houston-The Woodlands-Sugar Land MSA population.
- The Houston MSA is home to the nation's fourth-largest Hispanic population. Its Hispanic population of 2.7 million in '19 and marks the second consecutive year that the Hispanic population is larger than the Anglo population.
- The Houston-The Woodlands-Sugar Land MSA contains the nation's ninth-largest Asian population (550,675)—larger than the total population of the Corpus Christi, Brownsville or Beaumont MSAs.
