



Q2 How large is your workforce in Houston?





Q3 Since March 2020 (beginning of the pandemic), the number of employees at your firm has:






Q5 Which figure best represents the percentage decrease in your employee count since March 2020:


Q6 Does your company employ a significant number of office workers in Houston's central business district?




Q8 What type of incentive is your company offering (or planning to offer) to encourage employees to get vaccinated? (Check all that apply)


Q9 Are you tracking employee vaccination status?

Q10 How are you tracking employee vaccination status?







Q11 How is your company handling employee mask-wearing in your indoor office spaces?







Q14 When do you expect to fully reopen your operations (irrespective of how many days per week employees will be required to be present)?








Q17 Will you have a day (i.e., each week, each month) in which you expect all staff to be in the office at the same time?




Q18 How often will you expect all staff to be in the office at the same time?
